

ORDINANCE 83 - 1

ADOPTION OF UNIFORM RULES OF THE ROAD
UNDER NEW GEORGIA OFFICIAL CODE

Be it ordained by the City Council of Dahlonega, and it is hereby ordained by the authority thereof:

Pursuant to its corporate authority to regulate traffic upon the public streets of the City of Dahlonega and repealing all ordinances and sections of ordinances in conflict therewith, under the auspices of Official Code of Georgia Code Section 40-6-372, and other authority under the laws of the State of Georgia, Title 40—6 of the Official Code of Georgia 1 through 395 (except for Sections 40-6-3, 40-6-393, 40-6-245, 40-6-299, 40-6-370, 40-6-371, 40-6-372, 40-6-373, 40-6-374, 40-6-376, except for subsections 3 and 5) are hereby adopted as and for the traffic regulations of this municipality with the like effect as if recited herein, this ordinance repealing and superseding any former ordinance dealing with the same subject matter.

The provisions of this section relating to the operation of vehicles refer to the operation of vehicles upon highways or streets of this municipality, and as follows:

- (1) Except where a different place is specifically referred to in a given section.
- (2) The provisions of this section shall apply to a vehicle operated at shopping centers or parking lots or similar areas which, although privately owned, are customarily used by the public as a through street or connector street, overtime parking regulations excepted from operation on private property.
- (3) The provisions relating to reckless driving and to driving while under the influence of intoxicating liquors or drugs shall apply to vehicles operated upon highways or streets and elsewhere throughout the municipality.
- (4) Penalties for violation of the Uniform Rules of the Road shall not exceed 60 days in jail and a \$500.00 fine per offense.
- (5) A future amendment or repeal of a provision of Official Code of Georgia Title 40-6, Uniform Rules of the Road, shall so amend or repeal the pertinent provision of this section.
