- Q. Is there a parking committee of sorts that the consultant team will be working with?
- A. There is no parking committee at this time. We would expect that one would be created at the outset of this study.
- Q. Who will be the City's project manager throughout the study process?
- A. Mr. Ricky Stewart
- Q. Have any previous parking studies of a similar nature been completed and if so, how can we obtain a copy of this report?
- A. There have been no previous studies
- Q. What is the City's budget for this project?
- A. This has yet to be determined.
- Q. Can you provide us with number of municipal parking facilities that the consultant team will be reviewing as part of the Facilities Maintenance and Capital Improvements tasks?
- A. Currently the number of city-owned spaces is 415 including striped street parking and striped city parking lots.
- Q. Will the city provide the following?
- A. A document showing current land use of each property in the study area
 - B. A document showing future land use of each property in the study area
- A. Yes, we will create two map documents showing current and projected land uses in the project area.
- Q. How many copies of the proposal should be submitted to the city?
- A. Five (5)
- Q. We understand the scope of the parking facilities maintenance is to include only the facilities owned by the City. Please confirm this is correct. If not please identify the number and location of the parking facilities to be included in the scope. Additionally, where can we find information on the number and location of parking facilities owned by the City? The master plan does not appear to identify the City owned facilities.
- A. Yes, only City facilities should be included in the maintenance and capital improvement plan. The City will provide a map of the study area which shows existing City owned and leased facilities.
