

**ORDINANCE 2004-05
AMENDMENT 1**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE WITH RESPECT TO EVENING CURFEWS AND RESERVATION FEES IN HANCOCK PARK, CITY PARK AND ANTHONY PARK; SO AS TO PROHIBIT USE OF SAID PARKS DURING CERTAIN EVENING HOURS; TO MAKE IT UNLAWFUL TO VIOLATE SAID CURFEW; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

ORDINANCE 2004-05 IS HEREBY AMENDED AND RESTATED IN ITS ENTIRETY TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

Be it ordained by the City Council of Dahlonaga, and it is so ordained by the authority thereof that:

SECTION 1. HANCOCK PARK, CITY PARK AND ANTHONY PARK CURFEW.

The City Council of the City of Dahlonaga has determined that there will be a curfew set for Hancock Park, City Park and Anthony Park to prevent violence and crime by persons utilizing the park within the evening hours.

SECTION 2. CONDUCT PROHIBITED

It shall be unlawful for any person to loiter, wander, stroll, or otherwise be on or within the grounds of Hancock Park, City Park and Anthony Park between the hours of 9:00 pm and 7:00 am from the 1st day of April until the 31st day of October, and between the hours of 6:00 pm and 8:00 am from the 1st day of November until the 31st day of March except as permitted by formal written permission of the City of Dahlonaga.

SECTION 3. PENALTY FOR VIOLATION

Each offense under this section shall be punishable as a misdemeanor via citation to the Municipal Court of the City of Dahlonaga, and each offense shall incur a fine of \$100.00.

SECTION 4: RESERVATION FEES

Hancock Park and Anthony Park are not available for reservation.

City Park is available for 4 hour reservation for a fee of \$60 for a non-City resident or non-City property owner and \$45 for City residents or City property owners.

Residency requirements for this ordinance shall mean any person who lives or owns property within the city limits of Dahlonaga.

Residency shall be determined by driver's license, utility bill, tax records, or other reasonable documentation of the purchaser or deceased.

The provisions of this ordinance shall repeal and supersede any conflicting provisions existing in any other ordinance of the City of Dahlonega.
